Tuolumne Utilities District's Kampa Re-Elected to CSDA Board

[Sacramento, CA] – Pete Kampa, general manager of the Tuolumne Utilities District, has been re-elected to the California Special Districts Association's (CSDA) 18-member board of directors. The CSDA Board has also elected him to serve as Secretary of the Board. He is one of three directors representing CSDA region two, an area that covers 18 counties, including Sierra, Nevada, Glenn, Yolo, San Joaquin and Tuolumne. Kampa was elected to a three-year term in an election conducted by mail in August.

"CSDA provides educational programs and other resources that are absolutely necessary for special district governing officials" stated Kampa. "I actively participate to ensure that districts throughout the state have the tools necessary to provide high quality, efficient and transparent public services. The more districts perform well for their communities, the less additional costly regulation gets piled on by the state," stated Kampa. Kampa currently serves as General Manager of the Tuolumne Utilities District in Sonora and has served as general manager for community services districts and water/wastewater districts in California since 1993, and has served as a director for CSDA since 1998. During his time with CSDA, Kampa has actively participated on the Education, Membership and Legislative Committees, serving as Membership chair from 2007 through 2010.

"During my years of service on the CSDA Board, we have implemented extremely successful special district education and legislative programs and other highly valuable membership resources," says Kampa. "I believe I am the right person to help CSDA continue the positive progress toward providing the most affordable and best services possible, as well as the highest level of positive influence in the state Capitol."

The term for which Kampa has been re-elected to serve runs from 2012-2014.

CSDA has over 1,000 members and is the only statewide association representing all special districts in California. CSDA's board consists of three directors from each of six regions throughout California. The board meets bi-monthly to guide the association's legislative and member benefits programs.
