## **SATURDAY, 12/3/11 UPDATE FROM TUD CEDAR RIDGE CUSTOMERS NEED EMERGENCY WATER CONSERVATION**

SONORA, CA: PG & E and Tuolumne Utilities District (TUD) crews continue to work as quickly as possible to restore water to normal operating service following the recent wind storms to hit the area. This morning, TUD customers are still being asked to use as little water as possible.

**Cedar Ridge** customers especially are of great concern. Water levels at the Cedar Ridge water storage tank this morning are lower than expected. We are asking all Cedar Ridge customers to limit all water use immediately.

Other areas of concerns that should be on emergency water conservation measures are:

- Sugar Pine, Lakewood Park, Forest Vista, Confidence and Brentwood.

The wind storm has also affected water running through the TUD water distribution ditch system which feeds water into TUD's water treatment plants. The water storage tanks that serve these areas will become low and there is a chance of water running out if conservation measures are not taken.
