EMERGENCY WATER CONSERVATION URGED IN AREAS OF TUOLUMNE COUNTY

SONORA, CA: Due to the wind storm to hit the county, water flow has been compromised that supplies water from the Tuolumne Utilities District (TUD) ditch system to its water treatment plants. Tuolumne Utilities District (TUD) is urging residents to limit all water use in the following areas:

Soulsbyville	Willow Springs	Ridgewood
Crystal Falls – all areas	Sonora Meadows	Sonora Vista
Comstock Ranch	Ranchos Poquitos	Curtis Creek
Monte Grande	Tuolumne City	Confidence
Sugar Pine	Lakewood	Brentwood

TUD is asking the residents listed above to limit their water consumption as much as possible. The storm has affected water running through the TUD water distribution ditch system which feeds water into TUD's water treatment plants. The water storage tanks that serve these areas will become low and there is a chance of water running out if conservation measures are not taken.

Water Conservation Measures are urged

- No outside watering
- Wash full loads of laundry
- Turn off your automatic lawn and drip sprinkler timer
- Shorten your showers by a minute or two
